Until the appointment of a successor Thomas Loock will continue to serve as interim Managing Director Finance & Administration TNT Innight Management Europe GmbH and TNT Innight GmbH & Co.KG while continuing as Managing Director of Finance & Administration for TNT Express Germany.

The appointment of Philip Alliet marks an important step towards sharpening the focus on the respective core activities and business fields of TNT Innight and TNT Express and will support further sustainable growth and value enhancement for both companies.
